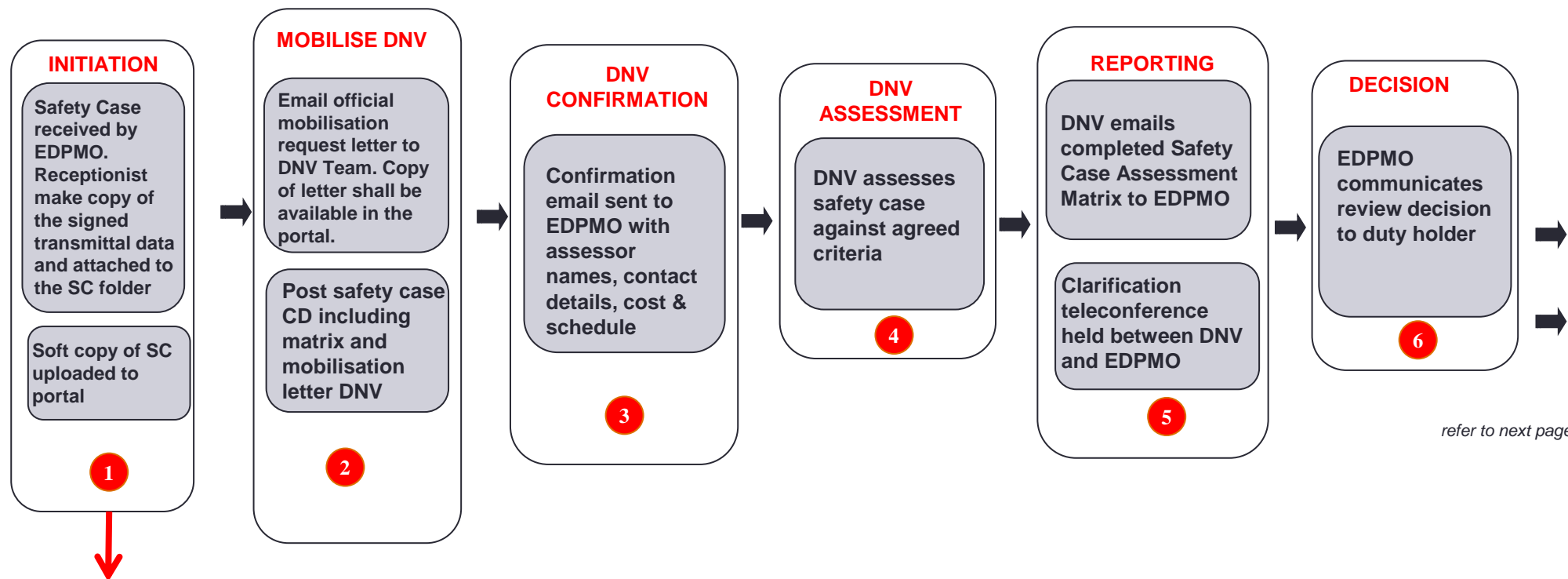

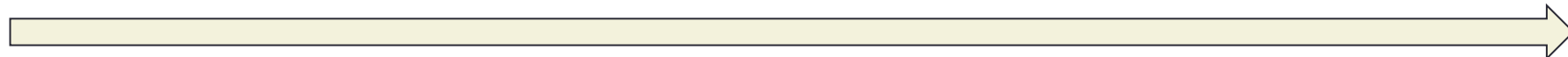

Responsibility of duty holder to cascade

Duties of principals.

WSHO

14. (1) Subject to subsection (2), it shall be the duty of every principal to take, so far as is reasonably practicable, such measures as are necessary to ensure the safety and health of –

(a) any contractor engaged by the principal when at work;

(b) any direct or indirect sub-contractor engaged by such contractor when at work;

(c) any employee employed by such contractor or sub-contractor when at work.



Transition Period

- Transition period originally put in Working draft rev 3 issued Oct 2012
6 months from commencement date of regs.
- Removed after discussion with AGC – No legacy clauses in regs
- Transition period will be provided “administratively” to allow industry time to comply with COMAH Safety case submission requirements.
- COMAH regs in for signing and will be back dated to 1 November

Transition period will therefore be 1 November 2013 to 1 May 2014.

All existing Facilities as of 1 November 2013 must submit a valid safety case within transition period. This will be reviewed by EDPMO (see safety case review process)



Safety Case and Notification Submission

Activity	Notification/Submission periods
Design and Relocation notifications for a fixed facility	3 months before start of detailed design
Safety Case for a fixed facility	6 months before commencing operation
Safety Case for a mobile facility	3 months before moving into State Land
Safety case for combined operations	21 days before it is due to commence
Safety Case for dismantling a fixed facility	3 months before commencement of dismantling
Notification of well operations	21 or 10 days before it is due to commence
Thorough review of safety cases	Every 5 years

Combined operation safety cases will be required once the fixed and mobile facilities have a safety case certificate.

Notification of well operations start date will be announced after signing of regs
