

COMMENCEMENT DATE OF COMPOUNDING OF OFFENCES

FOR NON-APPOINTMENT OF WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (WSH) OFFICER, NON-APPOINTMENT OF WSH CO-ORDINATOR, AND BREACH OF FIRST-AID REQUIREMENTS



SHENA hereby notifies all Principals, Occupiers, Employers, and Self-Employed Persons on the implementation of compounding of offences for contraventions at workplace on the following:

Appointment of a WSH Officer

Appointment of a WSH Co-ordinator



Requirements of the Workplace Safety and Health (First-Aid) Regulations, 2021





REQUIREMENT UNDER

REGULATION 8 OF WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH OFFICERS) REGULATIONS, 2014

Occupier must appoint a WSH Officer in the following listed workplaces:

- Shipyards in which any ship, tanker and other vessels are constructed, reconstructed, repaired, refitted, finished or broken up.
- Factories used for processing petroleum or petroleum products.
- Factories in which building operations or works of engineering construction of a contract sum of BND 10 million or more are carried out.
- Any other factories in which 100 or more persons 4 are employed, except those which are used for manufacturing garments.

Failure to appoint a WSH Officer in the above listed workplace, it is a compoundable offence with a sum not exceeding one-half of the amount of the maximum fine that is prescribed for the offence or a sum of BND 5,000, whichever is the lower.

REQUIREMENT UNDER

REGULATION 6 OF WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (CONSTRUCTION) REGULATIONS, 2014

Occupier of a workplace must appoint a WSH Co-ordinator for each worksite where the contract sum of the building operation or works of engineering construction (BOWEC) carried out is less than BND 10 million.

Failure to appoint a WSH Co-ordinator in the above worksite, it is a compoundable offence with a sum not exceeding one-half of the amount of the maximum fine that is prescribed for the offence or a sum of BND 5.000. whichever is the lower.

REQUIREMENT UNDER

WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (FIRST-AID) REGULATIONS, 2021



Duty of any Occupier of a Workplace, except any hospital, medical clinic and any ambulance to comply with all provisions under the Workplace Safety and Health (First-Aid) Regulations, 2021.

Any person reasonably suspected of having committed such offence(s) may be compounded with a sum not exceeding one-half of the amount of the maximum fine that is prescribed for the offence or a sum of BND 5,000, whichever is the lower.
