Purpose: This Note to Industry (NTI) seeks to inform training providers concerning the provisions and update of safety and health related training courses in Brunei Darussalam and as general reminder to ensure compliance with the Workplace Safety and Health Order, 2009 (WSHO, 2009) and the regulations thereunder.

SHENA is pleased to announce the training course syllabus on Brunei Darussalam Workplace Safety and Health Order, 2009 as per **Appendix A**. This course aims to provide learners with good understanding of Brunei Darussalam's Workplace Safety and Health Legislations. SHENA will implement written examination of Brunei Darussalam Workplace Safety and Health Order, 2009 starting 1st October 2023 for Workplace Safety and Health Officer renewal application.

Approved Training Providers (ATP) who intend to deliver the training course syllabus will need to be registered first with SHENA <u>using the online form</u> available on SHENA website under Licenses & Registrations tab.

Once the submission is made, SHENA will review and update the status of the application accordingly. Upon approval, the ATP will receive a letter of approval from SHENA that will allow the ATP to run the training course using the syllabus as attached. SHENA will also publish the list of ATP with the qualified trainers for public viewing on SHENA official website www.shena.gov.bn. SHENA would like to remind that **no training provider is permitted to run the training course** until an approval letter is obtained from SHENA. Training providers that fail to adhere to the requirement above may be subject to suspension of the approval given as approved training provider with SHENA as per Section 35 of WSHO, 2009.
