**Purpose:** This Radiation Technical Note serves to update stakeholders who have dealings and engagements with the Radiation Department under the Safety, Health and Environment National Authority (SHENA) with respect to emergency preparedness and response requirements outlined in Part 10 of Radiation Protection Programme (RPP). **This Radiation Technical Note to all Radiation Licensees is effective 24th June 2020 until further notice.** 

In the effort to streamline the regulatory framework on radiation matters in Brunei Darussalam, SHENA is hereby pleased to inform that Radiation Licensees are required to officially notify all radiological incidents or accidents to the Radiation Department at SHENA within 24 hours upon discovery through the radiological emergency Hotline +673 737 0240 that operates on a 24/7 basis.

In the event of a radiological incident or accident, Licensees shall carry out their internal investigations to determine the circumstances leading to the radiological accident or incident and its consequences. The internal investigation report shall be submitted to the SHENA within thirty (30) days of the accident or incident via email at <a href="mailto:rademergency@shena.gov.bn">rademergency@shena.gov.bn</a>.

SHENA would like to remind all radiation stakeholders to ensure that their agents are made aware of these new arrangements. Every licensee is advised to update their radiological emergency contact details.
