Purpose: This Radiation Technical Note (RTN) serves to update stakeholders who have dealings and engagements on radiation matters with the Safety, Health and Environment National Authority (SHENA) as stipulated under Sections 6 and 7 of the Radiation Protection Act, Cap 228. **This RTN to Radiation Licensees is effective on Thursday, 31**st **August 2023.**

In a continuous effort to improve the efficiency of its online services, SHENA hereby informs that e-SHENA Online Registration Portal (ORP) for Radiation Licensing and Radiation Workers Registration will be temporarily taken out of service to undergo some maintenance and upgrading work until further notice. To ensure continuity of the above services during this period, SHENA will revert to manual processing of Radiation Licensing and Radiation Workers Registration in accordance with current SHENA Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). In this respect, Radiation Licensees are required to submit the following applications via email to radapplication@shena.gov.bn:

- i) Radiation Licence Application (New, Renewal and Amendment); and
- ii) Radiation Workers (Radiation Protection Officers and General Radiation Workers) Registration (New and Renewal).

The forms and checklists required for the respective applications are available for download on SHENA website under the Licenses and Registrations tab, which may be accessed via this <u>link</u>. For termination of radiation workers, the Radiation Licensees are required to submit the application for termination through an official letter to SHENA together with the submission of the latest dose records and medical fitness report via email to <u>radapplication@shena.gov.bn.</u>
